

#### Fund Strategy

Higher risk

A flexible fund that is focused on generating high level of income together with long-term capital growth from bonds and equities. Within the bond portion, the bias is towards investing in higheryielding bonds across a broad range of sectors, particularly financials. To increase the opportunities for dividend income and potential capital growth, the fund also holds an allocation to European equities. The fund managers also use cash and government bonds to manage downside risk.


