## Risk Considerations

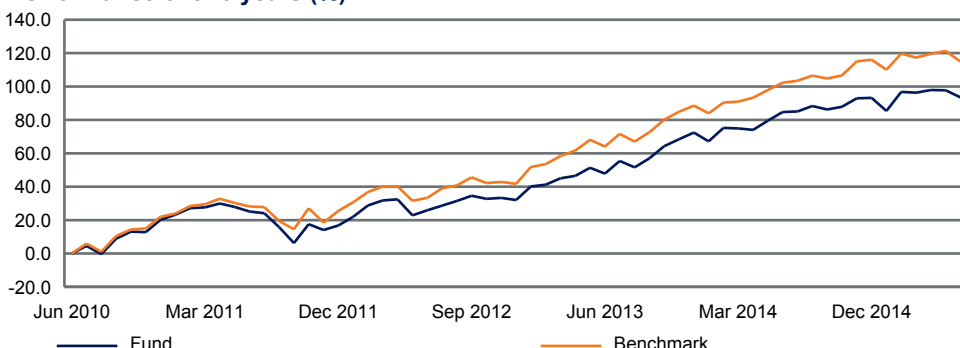

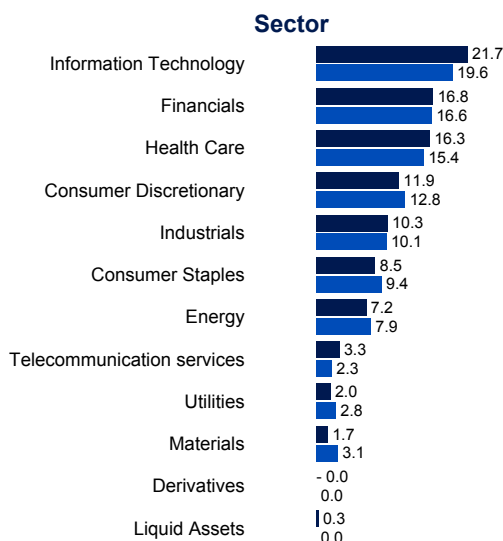
