Investment

Investment Objective

The objective of the Fund is to achieve annualised capital appreciation in the long term through a risk adjusted outperformance against the benchmark.

Investment Universe

The Fund will invest at least 75% of its total assets in equity and equity related securities issued by companies that are headquartered in Europe, or conduct the preponderant part of their activity in Europe.

Fund Manager's Comment

The Alken European Opportunities Fund fell -3.64% in June against -0.63% for the Stoxx 600 benchmark. This brings the underperformance to -0.47% for the year to date.

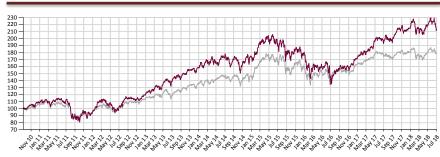
Market volatility continued in June driven by heightened trade tensions between the US and its major trade partners, notably China. The real economic impact of a trade war is yet to be measured but it has the potential to damage business confidence just as the capex cycle builds up. Oil prices were under pressure following the OPEC's agreement to increase output although recent inventory data in the US boosted prices again.

Within the fund, Wirecard performed well in June as increased investor interest in technology growth stories compounded the stock's robust fundamentals. Elis recovered after a weak start to the year following various broker upgrades highlighting the potential of the business. Aroundtown proved resilient in a difficult market environment owing to its exposure to undermanaged real estate assets.

On the downside, the auto sector was under pressure triggered by fears of increased trade barriers - although the only measure taken to date has been a tariff cut (from 25% to 15%) for car imports in China from all countries except the US. We believe the outcome will be better than the market is anticipating. Drillisch was down after the company indicated that increased competition was having an impact on customer additions. We believe this period of heightened promotional activity is unavoidable but remain confident in the competitive advantage of the business and its long-term growth prospects.

We expect market conditions to remain volatile in the near-term as the noise around the trade tariffs continues to grow. As a result, we have reduced our exposure to cyclical names which are more exposed to protectionist measures.

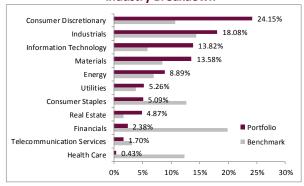

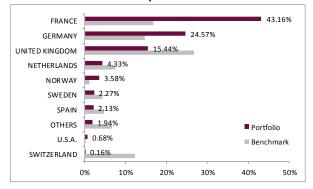
