Objectives and Investment Policy

Objective: Seeks to achieve positive returns in excess of cash over a full market cycle over the recommended holding period.

Portfolio securities: The Sub-Fund invests, directly or indirectly, in a broad range of securities from around the world, including emerging markets. These investments may include government and corporate bonds of any maturity, equities, convertible bonds and money market securities. The Sub-Fund may invest up to 100% of its assets in equities and up to 25% in convertible bonds. The Sub-Fund may invest up to 10% of its assets in contingent convertible bonds. The Sub-Fund's investments will mainly be denominated in euro, other European currencies, U.S. dollars or Japanese yen. The Sub-Fund makes extensive use of derivatives to reduce various risks, for efficient portfolio management and as a way to gain exposure (either long or short) to various assets, markets or income streams. This may generate a high level of leverage. In particular, the Sub-Fund may invest in short and medium-term interest rate swaps.

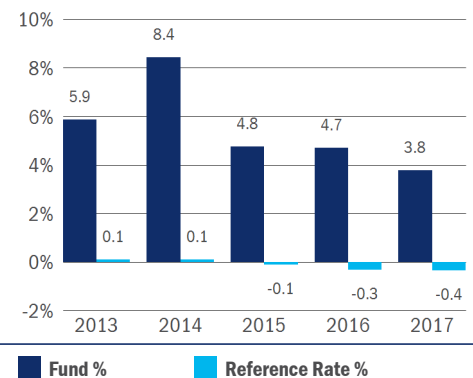
