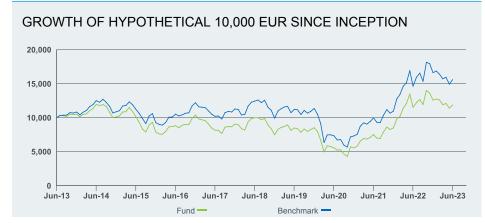

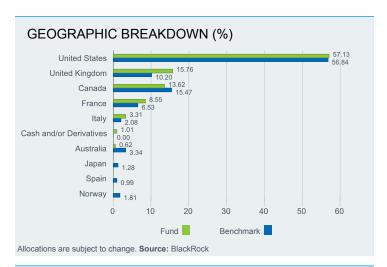

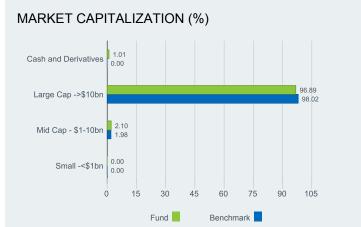

#### **GLOSSARY**
