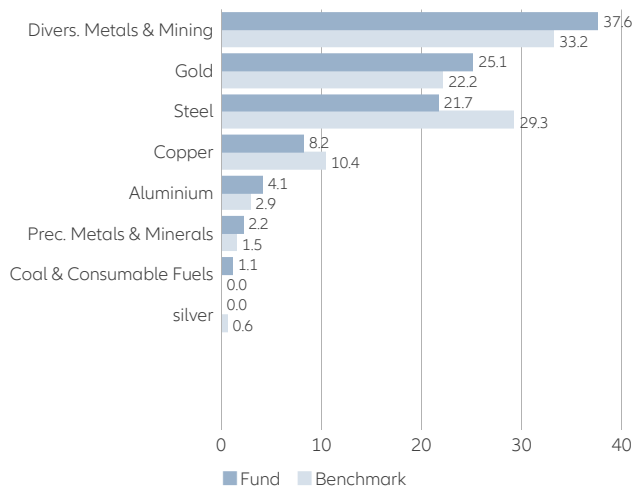

Portfolio Structure ⁸

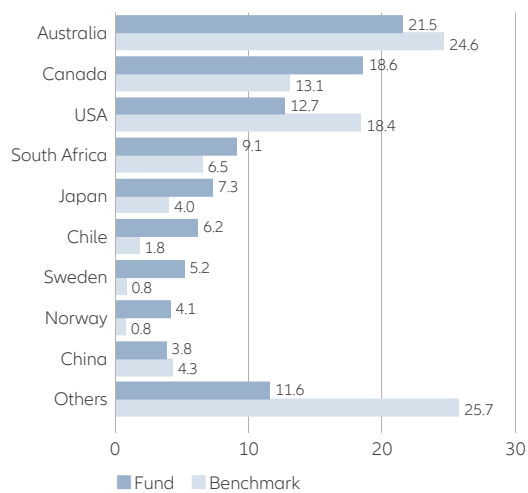
