INVESTMENT UNIVERSE

The fund invests mainly (without any sector or geographical restrictions) in equity funds (UCITS or UCIs) and accessorily in other investment funds (UCITS or UCIs). Accessorily, the fund can also invest directly or indirectly in equities, bonds and other debt securities (maximum 20% of net assets). The fund aims to limit its investments (directly or indirectly) in equities and other equity related securities to approximately 30% of net assets. At least 75% of net assets are invested in funds or securities that are selected based on compliance with environmental, social and governance criteria. The fund may, on an optional basis, use derivatives to achieve its goals or for hedging. This is an actively managed fund with no benchmark.



RISKS

This may result in the sub-fund being more exposed to companies that have a negative impact on sustainability. This risk may also be associated with the funds in which the fund invests.
