#### Fund objectives and investment policy


The fund aims to provide capital growth and income in excess of the JP Morgan Emerging Market Blend Equal Weighted Index after fees have been deducted over a three to five year period by investing in bonds issued by governments, government agencies, supra-nationals and companies from the emerging markets. The fund is actively managed and invests at least two-thirds of its assets in bonds issued by governments, government agencies and companies worldwide in various currencies. The fund does not invest more than 20% of its assets in asset-backed securities and mortgage-backed securities. The fund may invest in excess of 50% of its assets in bonds that have a below investment grade credit rating (as measured by Standard & Poor's or any equivalent grade of other credit rating agencies for rated bonds and implied Schroders ratings for non-rated bonds). The fund may also invest directly or indirectly in other securities (including other asset classes), countries, regions, industries or currencies, investment funds, warrants and money market investments, and hold cash. The fund may use derivatives with the aim of achieving investment gains, reducing risk or managing the fund more efficiently. The fund may use leverage and take short positions.

#### **Risk considerations**

**Credit risk:** A decline in the financial health of an issuer could cause the value of its bonds to fall or become worthless.

Currency control decisions made by the Chinese government could affect the value of the fund's investments and could cause the fund to defer or suspend redemptions of its shares.

**Interest rate risk:** The fund may lose value as a direct result of interest rate changes. **Emerging Markets & Frontier risk:** Emerging markets, and especially frontier markets, generally carry greater political, legal, counterparty, operational and liquidity risk than developed markets.

**Counterparty risk:**The fund may have contractual agreements with counterparties. If a counterparty is unable to fulfil their obligations, the sum that they owe to the fund may be lost in part or in whole.

**IBOR:** The transition of the financial markets away from the use of interbank offered rates (IBORs) to alternative reference rates may impact the valuation of certain holdings and disrupt liquidity in certain instruments. This may impact the investment performance of the fund.




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
#### **Asset allocation**
