Objectives and Investment Policy

The Fund aims to achieve a high level of income by actively managing which means that is not managed in reference of a benchmark.

The Fund mainly invests in debt issued by or linked to (i) Latin American companies, (ii) companies which carry out most of their business in Latin America, (iii) companies controlled by Latin American entities and by (iv) Latin American governments and institutions.

The debts can be issued in the local Latin American currencies as well as other hard currencies (including but not limited to Euro, US dollar and the British pound).

The Fund may use foreign exchange hedging transactions to aim to reduce the effect of fluctuations in value of USD against non-USD currencies in which the Fund's assets are denominated.

On a secondary basis, the Fund may also invest in promissory notes, deposits, cash, and in investments which can be easily converted into cash, such as Treasury Bills, short term government debt and money market funds.


The Fund may use financial contracts (derivatives) only to minimize market and other risks (including but not limited to interest and credit risk).


The charges you pay are used to pay the costs of running the Fund, including the costs of marketing and distributing it. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.
