Objectives and investment policy

Objectives

To provide long-term capital growth through exposure to companies located in frontier markets throughout the world. Long-term perspective, fundamental analysis and active stock-picking are three main pillars of our investment philosophy.

Investment policy

The sub-fund will invest at least 75% of its assets directly or indirectly in equity or equity-related securities (such as, but not limited to, ADRs and GDRs) of companies domiciled in frontiers markets or that exercise a significant part of their economic activity there. For the purpose of this sub-fund, frontier markets are defined as less advanced and less accessible emerging market countries that are included in Frontier Markets-related indices.

The sub-fund may also invest in any country which is classified as an Emerging Market, or any other market not yet classified as Frontier

Markets, but which, in the opinion of the Investment Manager, demonstrates economic characteristics of countries included in the Frontier Markets-related indices.

The currency of the share class is expressed in EUR.

The investor may subscribe and redeem shares on each bank business day in Luxembourg.

These shares are capitalisation shares. Income and capital gains are reinvested.

Recommendation

Risk and reward profile



The sub-fund is a high-risk fund that invests in frontier markets, which means that fluctuations in price are common. This is because investments on the frontier stock markets are more likely to experience sharp rises and falls in value.

The category 5 means a rather high risk and consequently rather high potential losses and gains.

The risk category has been determined on the basis of historical and simulated data and may not be a reliable indication of the future risk profile. The risk and reward category shown does not necessarily remain unchanged and the categorisation of the fund may shift over time.

The lowest category of the risk indicator does not mean a risk-free investment.

Repayment of the initial investment is not guaranteed.

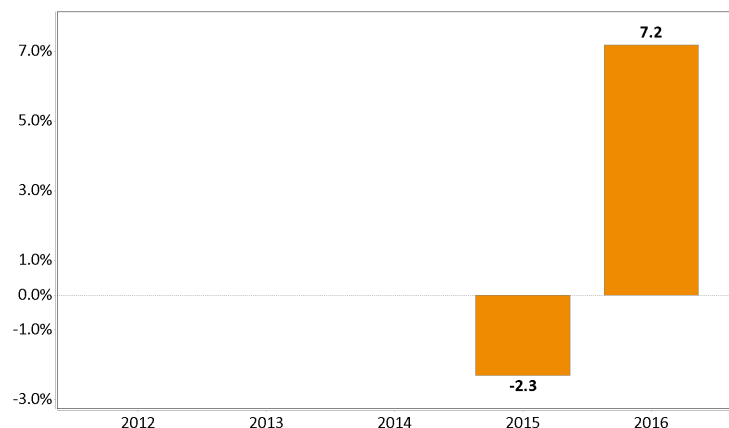
