Objectives and Investment Policy

The aim is to increase the value of your investment over the long-term by investing mainly in Japanese companies.

The Fund is actively managed and invests in shares and convertible securities (tradable debt which can be converted into shares) issued by companies, across a range of industries, based in Japan and traded on stock exchanges in developed countries.

The investment manager has discretion to select the companies it chooses to invest in but does take into consideration the universe of companies represented by the TOPIX Index (Total Return). While the Index may inform the selection of potential

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


Charges
