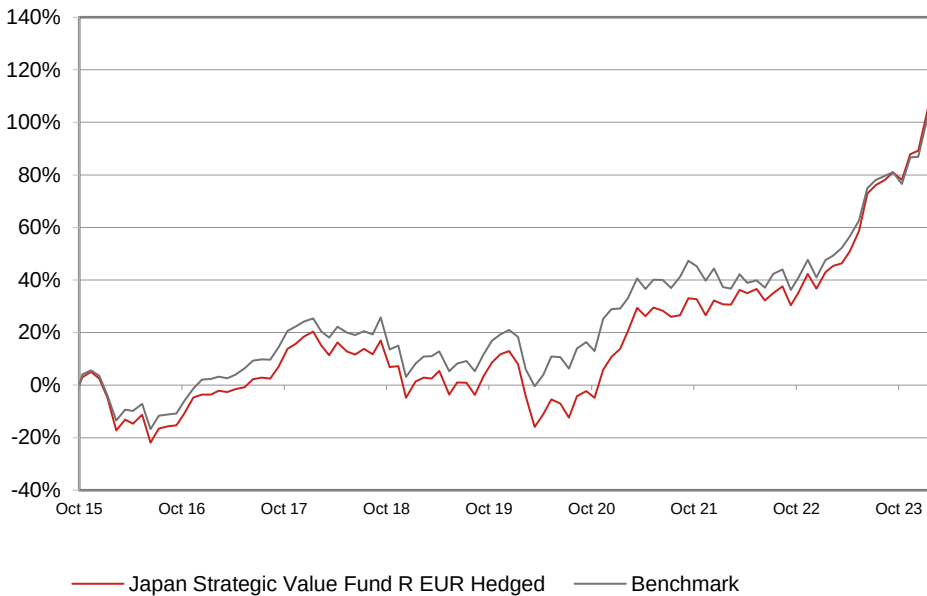


INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

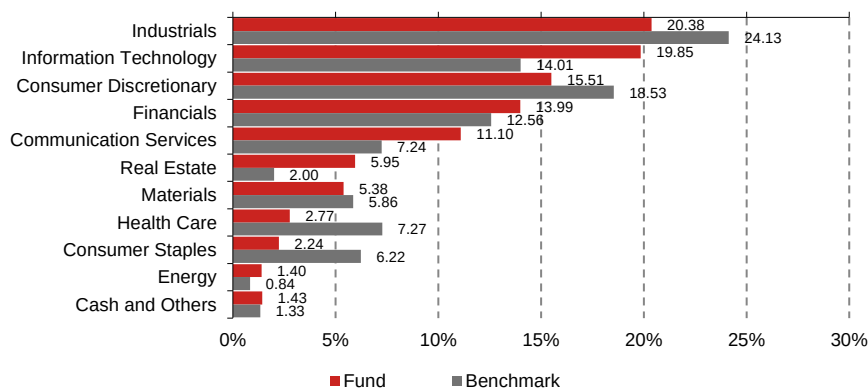
