

PGIM BROAD MARKET U.S. HIGH YIELD BOND FUND

The investment objective of the PGIM Broad Market U.S. High Yield Bond Fund (the "Fund") is to achieve a return through a combination of current income and capital appreciation while preserving invested capital. There is no guarantee that this objective will be achieved. The benchmark of the Fund is the Bloomberg U.S. High-Yield 1% Issuer Capped Index. The Fund will be invested in a diversified portfolio consisting primarily of high yield bonds that are originated in the US corporate bond markets. These high yield bonds will largely be a mix of fixed and floating rate instruments that are rated below investment grade. The Fund seeks to add value through active management by identifying and capturing relative value opportunities within the US high yield bond market with an active, risk managed approach using fundamental credit analysis. The Fund incorporates environmental, social and governance ("ESG") factors into its investment process and promote certain sustainability characteristics. **PGIM Fixed Income has determined that the Fund qualifies as a Light Green Fund, which is a fund that seeks to comply with the principles of Article 8 of the SFDR.** The fund reclassified from Article 6 to Article 8 on 12 June 2023.
