Investment focus

The fund's aim is to achieve capital growth in the long term. The Bellevue Healthcare Strategy fund invests in global healthcare companies with innovative business models. Its investment universe consists of biotechnology and pharma companies, medical technology and services companies as well as generics producers that are involved in the development, manufacturing or sale of products and services. Experienced sector specialists focus on profitable companies that have a well-established product portfolio. The fund invests top down in the four regions North America, Western Europe, Emerging Markets and Japan/Oceania. For each of these regions, the most attractive companies are determined based on quantitative and qualitative criteria. The fund seeks to outperform the MSCI World Healthcare Index. The fund takes ESG factors into consideration while implementing the aforementioned investment objectives.

Market review

MSCI World Healthcare underperformed MSCI World in November 2023 by 364 bps (MSCI World Healthcare +5.7% vs MSCI World +9.4%). The Bellevue Healthcare Strategy (Lux) Fund (I-shares: +6.4%, in USD) outpaced (by 68 bps) its healthcare index benchmark net of fees. Overweight positions in mid-caps and Asia-Pacific proved to be positive.

Easing inflation and encouraging economic data provided some relief for risk-on and cyclical sectors in November. As such, the healthcare sector was unable to keep up with the performance of more cyclical sectors such as financials (+10.8%) and consumer discretionary (+10.8%), or against another strong performance from IT (+13.7%) in the month. With the end of Q3 results, large broker conferences, and several capital markets days/R&D days, management commentary had a significant impact on both subsector and single-stock performances in the month.

Turning to individual subsectors within the MSCI World Healthcare, life science tools (+13.9%) was by far the best performer in the month supported by positive management commentary, a rebound from a tough prior period, and aided by the risk-on market sentiment, followed by medtech (+11.2%) which was supported by a reversal in GLP-1 agonist risk, pharma (+4.1%), biotech (+3.4%) and healthcare services (+2.8%). On the other hand, the subsector healthcare IT (-6.1%) was a notable laggard. From a geographical point of view, the Asia (+7.4%) territory within the MSCI World Healthcare managed to record superior gains compared to the regions Europe (+5.5%) and US (+5.3%).

On a stock-specific basis, strong absolute performances (in USD) were reported during the month from Pro Medicus (+23.6%; 8-year contract with Oregon Health & Science University), Chugai Pharmaceutical (+19.6%; Q3 results and GLP-1 hope) and Hoya (+18.8%; 2Q net income beat estimates). Conversely, negative absolute performances were seen for Bumrungrad Hospital (-12.2%; seasonal softness in demand into Q4), Wuxi Biologics (-10.2%; investor concern that 2023 guidance was at risk after Wuxi Apptec cut in mid-October. This proved to be justified as Wuxi Biologics 2023 guidance was cut in early December), and Humana (-7.4%; possible merger deal with The Cigna Group, which could face regulatory scrutiny).

General description

The investment process for the Bellevue Healthcare Strategy Fund resembles the rulesbased investment process that Bellevue has successfully applied since 2007. In this approach, the 40 most attractive stocks in the healthcare sector worldwide are selected every six months. The Bellevue Healthcare team screens about 700 of the 4000 listed companies in the healthcare sector worldwide based on four quantitative criteria (PEG valuation, price/sales, sales growth and EBITDA/sales) and four qualitative criteria (assessing the company's management, product pipeline, operating risks and country-related risks). The ten most promising stocks from four different regions - Western Europe, North America, Japan/Australia and emerging markets - are selected. The maximum weighting of the region with the highest overall score, which is usually North America, is capped at 35% during the periodic rebalancing, which increases the emphasis given to emerging markets. Companies with rich valuations and low growth rates will rarely be selected for the portfolio. Mid cap stocks have typically represented 60-80% and the Asia region approximately onethird of the portfolio. Pharmaceutical stocks are clearly underweighted compared to the MSCI World Healthcare Index. Bellevue has applied this investment approach since April of 2007 and it is used to compile the Adamant Global Healthcare Index.
