Summary of Investment Objective:

The fund's goal is to achieve growth of the fund's value in the long term, through investment in a concentrated portfolio comprised primarily of shares of European companies.

Such investment may be directly in such shares or indirectly via derivatives (financial instruments whose value is derived from the value of other assets).


