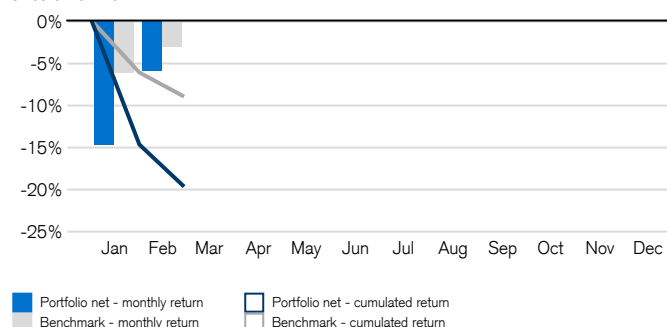

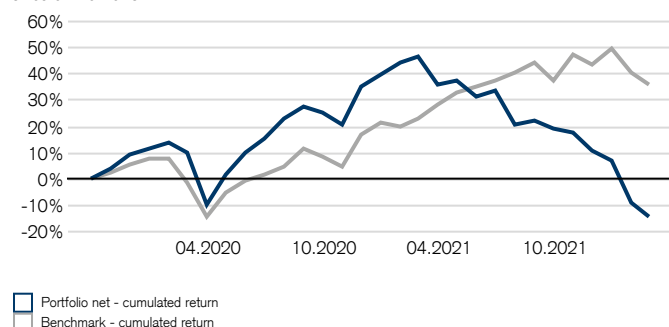
## Performance overview\* - monthly & cumulated

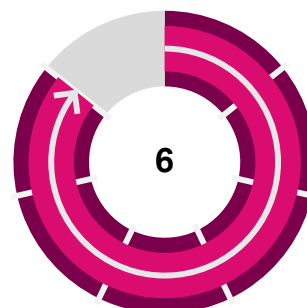
