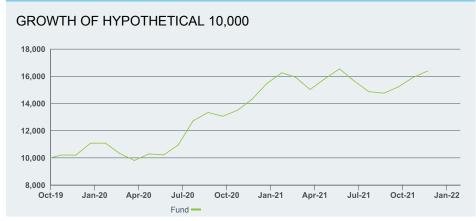

FUND OVERVIEW

The Fund aims to achieve long-term capital growth on the Fund's assets. The Fund invests at least 80% of its total assets in a portfolio of equity securities (e.g. shares) of companies domiciled in, or exercising the predominant part of their activity in, or from, the People's Republic of China (PRC) and whose goods and services seek to address the PRC's social and environmental problems. The Fund invests in "impact" investments which are those made with the intention to generate positive, measurable social and/or environmental impact alongside a financial return. The Fund's total assets will be invested in accordance with the ESG Policy described in the prospectus which includes the BlackRock EMEA Baseline Screens whereby the Investment Adviser (IA) will seek to limit and/or exclude direct investment (as applicable) in issuers which, in the opinion of the IA, have exposure to, or ties with, certain sectors. 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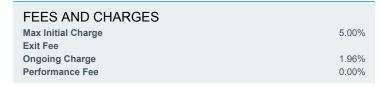

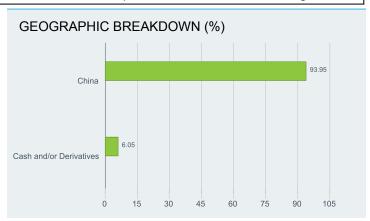

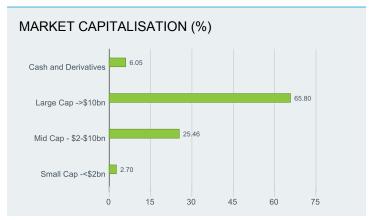
