Objective and Investment Policy

Investment Objective

The objective of the Sub-Fund is to seek to generate income through dynamic exposure to the global short duration fixed income universe.

Investment Policy

The Investment Manager will seek to achieve the objective of the Sub-Fund by investing in a diversified portfolio of short duration transferable securities (rated investment grade or non-investment grade) including inflation-linked bonds, issued by governments, corporations or institutions located anywhere in the world, including emerging markets countries, denominated in hard currency (globally traded major currencies) and money market instruments. The Sub-Fund may invest up to 60% of its net assets in non-investment grade debt securities (i.e., rated lower than BBB- by Standard & Poor's or Fitch or lower than Baa3 by Moody's or, if unrated, then deemed to be so by the Investment Manager).

The asset allocation of the Sub-Fund will be driven by the AXA Fixed Income global investment process in order to create a diversified portfolio of short duration fixed income securities.

The selection of debt securities is not exclusively and mechanically based on their publicly available credit ratings but also on an internal credit and market risk analysis. The decision to buy or sell securities is also based on other analysis criteria of the investment manager.

There is no formal restriction on the proportion of the Sub-Fund's assets that can be invested and/or exposed to any particular fixed income securities with the exception of the exposure to non-investment grade debt securities. For efficient portfolio management and for hedging purposes, the Sub-Fund may use derivatives within the limit of 200% of the Sub-Fund's net assets.

The Share Class aims at hedging the foreign exchange risk resulting from the divergence between the reference currency of the Sub-Fund and the currency of this Share Class by using derivatives instruments whilst retaining the exposure to Investment Policy described above.

Sub-Fund Currency

The reference currency of the Sub-Fund is USD.

Investment Horizon

This Sub-Fund may not be suitable for investors who plan to withdraw their contribution within 3 years.

Processing of subscription and redemption orders

The subscription, conversion or redemption orders must be received by the Registrar and Transfer Agent on any Valuation Day no later than 3 p.m. Luxembourg time. Orders will be processed at the Net Asset Value applicable to the following Valuation Day. The investor's attention is drawn to the existence of potential additional processing time due to the possible involvement of intermediaries such as Financial Advisers or distributors. The Net Asset Value of this Sub-Fund is calculated on a daily basis.


