FUND OBJECTIVE

The fund aims to increase the value of your shares through a combination of growth and income, with an emphasis on current income, by investing in global high yield bonds which meet the Sustainable Investment Criteria as described in the prospectus supplement.

The fund invests primarily in US Dollar and non-US Dollar denominated high yield bonds that are issued by corporate entities of any industrial sector and primarily located in developed market countries. Engagement objectives aligned with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals will be established for each issuer in the fund. Progress toward engagement objectives will be evaluated semiannually by the Neuberger Berman ESG Investing Team. The alignment of an issuer's business products and services with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals and/or the potential for improved alignment through on-going engagement is key to the credit selection process.

There is no guarantee that this objective will be achieved and capital invested is at risk. The fund invests in securities that meet the criteria set out in Sustainable Exclusion Policy and exclude securities prohibited by the Enhanced Sustainable Exclusion Policy, as detailed in the Prospectus.


