Objectives and investment policy

The investment objective of the Fund is to achieve attractive and consistent risk adjusted returns with moderate volatility, lower drawdowns and reduced long term correlation to traditional markets.

To achieve the investment objective, the Investment Manager pursues a multistrategy approach across global equity and fixed income markets, with primary focus on developed markets.

The Investment Manager intends to take positions in these equities, corporate and government bond markets directly or through a range of derivatives instruments. These instruments include contracts for difference, warrants, listed futures and options. In particular, the Fund primarily uses Total Return Swaps to gain exposure to the investment strategy portfolio with the aim of achieving investment gains and to manage the Fund more efficiently.

The Fund will seek to generate its returns using a core discretionary long/short market neutral multi-strategy, multi-manager portfolio known as the "Core Market Neutral" portfolio. Each of these sub-strategies targets absolute returns through a long/short investment approach to specific focuses such as sector, regional, event orientation or other characteristics. The Investment Manager will analyse data using innovative tools to allocate across the sub-strategies. These tools assist in the investment decision making process at Core Market Neutral portfolio level and also at its substrategy level. Each sub-strategy will be managed by separate, dedicated teams within the Investment Manager.

The Core Market Neutral portfolio is complemented by two additional components, one comprising of growth assets such as equities, and the other of lower risk defensive assets such as bonds.

The Fund is actively managed, and is not managed in reference to a benchmark.

The currency of the Fund is USD and your shares will be denominated in EUR. Your shares will be hedged with the aim of protecting them from exchange rate fluctuations between their denominated currency and the currency of the Fund.

Your shares are non-distributing (i.e. any income arising from your shares will be included in their value).

You may redeem your shares on demand on each banking day, which is a UK, US and Luxembourg banking day.

Multi-Manager risk: Each sub-strategy and their management team operates autonomously of other sub-strategies and as a result, it is possible that one substrategy may enter into an investment which economically offsets the position entered into by another. The following are additional risks which are not captured in the risk category:

Counterparty risk: The risk that the other party to a transaction with the Fund may fail to fulfil its contractual obligations and may expose the Fund to financial losses.


