Objectives and Investment Policy

The objective of this Fund is to achieve long-term capital appreciation investing in globally diversified multi asset risk premia, while maintaining the Fund around an objective of annual volatility with a target around 6%.

The Fund will seek to achieve its objective through exposure to both traditional and alternative risk premia linked to several investment factors across a broad range of asset classes on all global markets.

The universe of risk premia the Fund may take exposure to includes but is not limited to: Value, Momentum, Carry, Volatility, Low volatility, Size and Quality.

The Fund will obtain exposure to asset classes either directly or indirectly through the use of financial derivative instruments and/or investments in other UCITS and/or UCIs, as permitted.

The fund's investments may include equities and equity-linked securities, government and corporate bonds, volatility indices, UCITS and/or other UCIs, REITs, as well as exchange traded and OTC financial derivative instruments such as, but not limited to, TRS (funded or unfunded), index or single name futures, dividend futures, CDS and options.

The Fund shall not invest more than:

50% of its net assets in equity;

35% of its net assets in Non-Investment Grade Credit Rating securities;

25% of its net assets in issuers of emerging market countries;

50% of its net assets in unhedged non-Euro currency.

Under extreme market circumstances the Fund may also hold, up to 100% of its net assets in liquidities such as cash deposits and Money Market Instruments.

The Fund may use financial instruments and derivatives for hedging purposes, for efficient portfolio management purposes and for investment purposes.

The Fund is open-ended. You may redeem shares of the Fund on any Luxembourg business day.

The Share Class makes no dividend payment.

The Fund is actively managed and references the Performance Fee Benchmark for the performance fee's calculation purpose.

The Performance Fee Benchmark of the Fund is ESTER + 200 bps Index.

Derivative Risk: The Fund uses derivative instruments to achieve higher performance through speculation on rising or falling prices. Increased opportunities may lead to increased risk of losses.

Counterparty Risk: The Fund primarily concludes derivatives trades with various contracting parties. There is a risk that counterparties may no longer be able to honour their payment or settlement obligations.
