



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

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## MONTHLY MANAGEMENT COMMENT

Materials, real estate, and communication services contributed most during the month on a sector basis, relative to the benchmark. Within materials, our out-of-benchmark allocation to Celanese and overweight to Graphic Packaging International contributed most relative to results. Shares of Celanese, an American technology and specialty materials company, rose over the period after the company agree to an RNA research pact with Secarna Pharmaceuticals. Graphic Packaging, a leader in consumer packaging solutions, rose over the period on limited news. Within real estate, our overweight to Lamar Advertising and not holding Equity Lifestyle Properties contributed most relative to results. Shares of Lamar Advertising, an outdoor advertising company which operates billboards, logo signs, and transit displays, rose over the period as CEO Sean Reilly told investors that adjusted funds from operations (AFFO) is tracking above the top end of 2024 guidance. Within communication services, not holding The New York Times and Iridium Communications contributed most to relative results. Industrials, information technology, and financials detracted most from relative results during the month. Within industrials, our out-of-benchmark allocation to Dayforce and an overweight to Genpact detracted most from relative results. Shares of Dayforce, a provider of human resources software and services, declined over the period on limited news. Shares of Genpact, a global professional services company, declined during the period on limited news. Within information technology, not holding Super Micro Computers and out-of-benchmark allocation to MongoDB detracted most from relative results. Shares of MongoDB fell over the period despite reporting fourth quarter results that beat expectations. The company provided soft guidance for the first quarter of fiscal 2025 as revenue estimates came in lower than expectations. Management also projected a stable 2025 environment for consumption-based software revenue after volatility in prior years. Lastly, within financials, our out-of-benchmark allocations to Shift4 Payments and Globe Life detracted most from relative results. Shares of payment processing company Shift4 Payments declined over the period after CEO Jared Isaacman said bids from potential buyout suitors failed to value the firm adequately. The company received "multiple offers" above its current share price. Shares of life insurance company Globe Life declined over the period despite raising its quarterly dividend by 6.7%.
