
JP Morgan Emerging Market Bond Index Global Diversified




## CALENDAR YEAR PERFORMANCE\* (Total return in USD)



## **GENERAL INVESTMENT POLICIES**

The Company's objective, based upon the principle of diversification of risk, is to manage its assets for the benefit of the shareholders of the Company ("the Shareholders") and to seek to achieve the objective of each Fund as more fully described above.

The following definitions, investment rules and restrictions apply to each and all Funds of the Company:

Where the term 'primarily' is used in the description of the specific investment objective of any Fund, at least two thirds of the assets of the relevant Fund will be invested as described.

Where the name of a Fund makes reference to a particular geographical area, sector or currency, at least two thirds of the assets of the relevant Fund will be invested in transferable securities and money market instruments as described in the Fund's specific investment objective, of entities established or conducting a predominant proportion of their business activities in that geographical area, sector or currency.

Where the name of a Fund makes reference to the term "equity" the Fund will invest at least two thirds of its assets in equity and/or equity related transferable securities, which include common stock, preferred stock, warrants on transferable securities and other rights to acquire stock, American Depository Receipts ("ADRs"), European Depository Receipts ("EDRs") and Global Depository Receipts ("GDRs") and not more than one third of their assets in convertible securities, bonds (with or without warrants) and short term debt securities.

Where the name of a Fund makes reference to the term 'bond' the Fund will invest at least two thirds of its assets in bonds (straight bonds). With regard to the other one third, the Fund may invest up to a maximum of 10 per cent of the assets of that Fund in equities and equity related securities and a maximum of 25 per cent of the assets of that Fund in convertible bonds and a maximum of one third of that Fund's assets in money market instruments provided, however, that such investments in the aggregate do not exceed one third of the Fund's assets.

In the context of the names and specific investment objectives of the various Funds, the following meanings will apply, unless more specifically defined.

Where the term **"investment grade"** is used in the description of corporate debt securities, such securities will be rated BBB- (Standard & Poor's or equivalent rating) or better by at least one recognised rating agency or, in the opinion of the Investment Manager, be of comparable quality.

Where the terms **"high yield"** or **"non investment grade"** are used in the description of corporate debt securities, such securities will be rated BB+ (Standard & Poor's or equivalent rating) or lower by at least one recognised rating agency or, in the opinion of the Investment Manager, be of comparable quality.

"US Large Cap" or "large US companies" are defined as US companies whose market capitalisation falls within or above the range covered by the Russell 1000 Index.

**"US Mid-Cap"** or **"medium-sized US companies"** are defined as US companies whose market capitalisation falls within the range covered by the Russell Mid Cap Index or S&P Mid Cap 400 Index.

"Blue Chip" companies are defined as those with leading market position, seasoned management and strong financial fundamentals.

Each of the Funds is managed in accordance with the investment and borrowing restrictions described under "Further Information – Investment Powers and Limitations" in the Company's current full prospectus.

The Company may, on an ancillary basis, purchase and sell for any Fund, options on transferable securities and on financial instruments and purchase and sell futures contracts, within the limits stated under "Further Information – Investment Techniques and Instruments" in the Company's current full prospectus. The use of any of these techniques and financial instruments will be in accordance with the investment policy.

Options and futures may also be used for hedging purposes and for efficient portfolio management.

The gearing effect of investment in some financial instruments and the volatility of the prices of futures contracts would normally make the risk attached to investment in the Shares of the Fund higher than is the case with conventional investment policies.

## FINANCIAL INFORMATION

## TAXATION

The Company is not liable for any Luxembourg tax on profits or income, nor are dividends paid by the Company subject to any Luxembourg withholding tax.

The Company is, however, liable in Luxembourg to a tax of 0.05% per annum in respect of the "Adviser Classes" and of 0.01% per annum in respect of the "Institutional Classes". Such tax being payable quarterly on the basis of the value of the aggregate net assets of the Company at the end of the relevant calendar quarter. No stamp duty or other tax is payable in Luxembourg on the issue of Shares. No Luxembourg tax is payable on the realised or unrealised capital appreciation of the assets of the Company. Income received by the Company on its investments may be subject to non-recoverable withholding or other taxes in the countries of origin.

Further taxation may apply to the income or capital gains received by individual investors under the relevant laws of the jurisdictions to which they are subject. If the investor is unclear as to his fiscal position, he should seek professional advice.

## FEES AND EXPENSES

## INFORMATION FOR INVESTORS IN DENMARK

Taxation in Denmark of Danish Investors	The taxation in Denmark of investors resident in Denmark is outlined below. The description below is based on Danish tax law as in place in November 2007.
	It is not possible to include all tax matters relating to an investment in T. Rowe Price Funds SICAV, and this outline is therefore not exhaustive. Investors should seek individual advice on the tax issues as the tax consequences may depend on the individual investor's tax situation.
Life insurance companies,	The Pension Savings Tax Regime
pension funds and deposits in pension accounts	Gains and losses are taxed at a flat rate of 15%. Gains and losses are taxed on an unrealised basis (according to the mark-to-market principle). Dividends are also included in the annual taxation basis.
	Life insurance companies are also liable to corporate tax and as such also subject to the tax rules described below under the heading "Companies and individuals".
	The taxation under the corporate tax rules covers the part of the income, which is not related to pure life insurance activity. The Pension Savings Tax Regime, on the other hand, aims at taxing the yield paid out to the insured. Special rules ensure that the life insurance companies are not subject to double taxation.
Companies and Individuals	Classification of a fund under the Danish tax headings
	Danish tax law makes a distinction between distributing funds and so called "investment companies", a definition set up for tax purposes only.
	A distributing fund is a fund that notifies the Danish tax authorities that it wants to be treated under the rules applicable to distributing funds and that it intends to meet the specific Danish tax reporting requirements. An investment company is inter alia an investment institution comprehended by the UCITS Directive 85/611 that does not want to be treated under the rules applicable to distributing funds.
	A foreign UCITS as e.g. T. Rowe Price Funds SICAV can elect to be categorised as a distributing investment fund instead of an investment company if the requirements hereof are fulfilled. The foreign UCITS fund must submit information of the election before 31 December of the first year the fund wants to be categorised as a distributing investment fund. Subsequently, the fund must follow the Danish rules for distributing investment funds in order to keep the status. If information or documentation is not submitted in due time, investors would be taxed as investing in an investment company for a period of the following five years.
	The tax treatment for a Danish investor in T. Rowe Price Funds SICAV (the Fund) depends on whether the Fund is perceived as a distributing investment fund or an investment company from a Danish tax perspective. The Fund is at the outset perceived as an investment company under Danish tax law unless the Fund elects to be classified as a distributing fund as described above.
Individuals	Investment companies
	Individuals investing in an investment company will be taxed on gains and losses as capital income, at a rate up to 59%. Gains and losses are calculated according to a mark-to-market principle, i.e. on an unrealised basis.
	Dividends are taxed as capital income at the rate described above.
	Distributing fund investing solely in shares
	Individuals investing in a distributing fund, which only invests in shares and only placing a maximum of 25% of its assets in cash or in financial instruments used for hedging purposes only, are taxed as share income on any distributions. The tax rate is 28% for an amount up to DKK 45,500 for 2007 (the amount is double for spouses) and 43% for the excess amount. As from 1 January 2008 individuals will in addition to the current rules be taxed at a rate of 45% for gains and losses exceeding DKK 10,000 (the amount is doubled for spouses).
	A gain will irrespective of size and ownership period be taxed as share income with the rates mentioned above. The treatment of a loss will depend on whether the shares are listed. A share in T. Rowe Price Funds SICAV is in this context considered to be listed for Danish tax purposes.
	Losses on listed shares can be set off against dividends and gains on other listed shares. An excess loss can be carried forward indefinitely and be set off against dividends and gains on listed shares in subsequent years or set off a spouse's dividends and gains on such shares.
	Losses on unlisted shares are set off against positive share income. Should the share income be negative, the tax value hereof can be set off against the tax payer's final taxes.

	Distributing fund investing in shares and other securities
	Individuals investing in a distributing fund, which invests in both shares and other securities, are taxed on any distributions based on the underlying securities they arise from. Distributions arising from bonds are taxed as capital income, cf. above and distributions arising from shares are taxed as share income, cf. above.
	Any capital gain on sale is taxed as capital income at a rate up to 59%. Any losses are generally not deductible.
	Distributing fund investing in bonds and receivables issued in foreign currency
	Individuals investing in a distributing fund, which invests in bonds and receivables issued in foreign currency, i.e. other than DKK, are taxed as capital income at a rate up to 59% on any distributions.
	Any capital gain on sale is also taxable as capital income and losses are deductible in capital income.
Companies	Investment companies
	Companies investing in an investment company are taxed at a rate of 25%. Gains and losses are calculated according to a mark-to-market principle, i.e. on an unrealised basis.
	Dividends are fully taxable.
	Distributing fund investing solely in shares
	Companies investing in a distributing fund, which solely invests in shares and only placing a maximum of 25% of its assets in cash or in financial instruments, are taxable on distributions. The part of the distribution that relates to dividends is subject to 25% tax on an amount of 66%. The part of the distribution that relates to gains on sale of shares held for less than three years is taxable at a rate of 25%, whereas the part that relates to gains on a sale of shares held for more than three years is tax exempt.
	Any gains on a sale that takes place within an ownership period of less than three years are taxable at a rate of 25%. Any losses realised on such shares can be offset against taxable gains on other shares held for less than three years. Any gains on shares held for more than three years are tax exempt and losses are not deductible.
	Distributing fund investing in shares and other securities
	Companies investing in a distributing fund, which invests in both shares and other securities, are taxable on any distributions based on the underlying securities they arise from. Distributions relating to shares are taxed as stated above under "Distributing fund investing solely in shares". Distributions relating relating to other securities are taxed at a rate of 25%.
	Any gains on a sale are taxable at a rate of 25%. Any losses are not deductible.
	Distributing fund investing in bonds and receivables
	Companies investing in a distributing fund, which invests solely in bonds and receivables, are taxable at a rate of 25% on distributions and any capital gains on sale. Any losses realised on a sale are deductible.
Banks	Banks investing in investment companies are taxed on gains and losses at a rate of 25% based on a mark-to-market principle, i.e. on an unrealised basis.
	Dividends are fully taxable.
	Banks investing in distributing funds are taxed on gains and losses at a rate of 25%, based on mark-to-
	market principles, i.e. on a unrealised basis.
