Investment objective

The Fund aims to provide long term capital growth and income by investing in a portfolio of United States of America (USA) shares.

Investment strategy

The Fund is actively managed and is not constrained by a benchmark. In normal market conditions, the Fund will invest at least 90% of its assets in shares (or securities similar to shares) of companies of any size that are based in, or carry out the larger part of their business activities in, the USA. The Fund's investment process identifies and invests in companies according to their economic scale, measured by their contribution to Gross National Product. This is also referred to as Value Added - the difference between a company's outputs and inputs. The Fund may invest up to 10% in Real Estate Investment Trusts, and may also invest up to 10% of its assets in other funds, including HSBC funds. 

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
